Under the California Public Records Act § 6250 et seq., on behalf of the board of directors of the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation, we are requesting an opportunity to inspect or obtain copies of public records, specifically:

PDF's of the approved sets of drawings for which building permits were issued for the Bank of America (588 South Palm Canyon Drive). Plan check numbers (building permit application numbers) are as follows:

(1) 2021-4721 Interior TI package, (2) 2021-4575 Exterior, and (3) 2021-4689 Roof

Mr. Ken Lyon of the city's planning department is aware of the location of these records.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform us if the cost will exceed \$500.00. However, we request a waiver of fees since the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of city government operations. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.

The California Public Records Act requires a response within ten business days. If access to the records we are requesting will take longer, please contact us with information about when we might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records. If you deny any (or all) of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify us of the appeal procedures available to us under the law.
