Dear Ms. Jenkins,

In consideration of Cal Poly Pomona, College of Environmental Design's efforts to archive the architectural photography works of Marvin Rand, the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation is pleased to award a \$5,000 grant. We acknowledge the importance of Mr. Rand's work in documenting the architectural history of Southern California and further acknowledge the important role Cal Poly Pomona has taken in preserving the archives of important Modernist architects like Donald Wexler, Richard Neutra, and Raphael Soriano. We feel that Mr. Rand's archive is an important historical artifact that will aid students and researchers in continuing to document the rich architectural heritage of our region.

This grant is subject to the following conditions:

1. That PSPF be permitted to make announcements regarding this grant to publicize our grant program; and
2. That all PSPF funds will be expended to archive and digitize all relevant images within the Rand collection that depict Palm Springs and the Coachella Valley area architecture;
3. That PSPF be granted limited-use, non-exclusive permission to use Palm Springs and the Coachella Valley area images in communications to our membership regarding this grant, including social media and Palm Springs Modernism Week events; and
4. That all PSPF funds be properly expended by December 31, 2027.

We will consider Cal Poly Pomona's deposit of the attached check as acceptance of our conditions.
