On May 1, 2022, the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation's board of directors voted to "re-commit" our \$50,000 grant to support the city's rehabilitation of the Plaza Theatre. We have been very encouraged by the city's recent fundraising successes and are happy to recommit this grant money.

As background, in December of 2020, we asked the city to return the PSPF grant awarded in June of 2019 when it appeared that fundraising efforts for the rehabilitation of the Plaza Theatre had stalled. The PSPF board felt this action was consistent with our fiduciary responsibilities.

On a separate note, because the city's financial situation has improved so dramatically, we would encourage the city to now make a formal, and significant, commitment of funds to this project to ensure its ultimate success.

Of course, should the city's fundraising efforts ultimately prove insufficient for the rehabilitation of the Plaza Theatre, PSPF requests the return of this grant money.
