Dear Ms. Gray,

On April 1, 2024 the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation's board of directors voted unanimously to support your efforts to accession the papers of architect Kendrick Bangs Kellogg to the Architecture and Design Collection (ADC) located at the Art, Design & Architecture Museum (AD&A Museum) at the UC Santa Barbara (UCSB). PSPF feels especially privileged to support your efforts as the Coachella Valley was home to one of Kellogg's masterpieces, i.e., the Chart House Restaurant (1978) in Rancho Mirage.

To that end, we are forwarding a grant check in the amount of \$5,000.00 to support "Phase 1" of your accessioning effort as outlined in the UCSB's AD&A Museum brochure *The Kendrick Bangs Kellogg Project* forwarded by Ms. Silvia Perea's letter of February 26, 2024. This grant is subject to the following conditions:

1. That PSPF is authorized to make an announcement regarding this grant to publicize our grant program;

2. That all PSPF grant monies will be returned to PSPF should UCSB's AD&A Museum fail to accession the relevant Kellogg papers; and,

3. That all PSPF funds are properly expended by December 31, 2027.

We will consider your redemption of the attached check as acceptance of the aforementioned conditions. Additionally, we would ask that you provide periodic updates on the progress of the project. We thank Ms. Silvia Perea, curator of your museum's ADC, for bringing this grant opportunity to our attention.
