Dear Luke,

Thank you for briefing the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation (PSPF) board of directors at our October 3, 2022 meeting on your recent research into architect R. M. Schindler's work in the Coachella Valley. After some discussion, the board voted unanimously to support your future research efforts in the amount of \$6,000.00.

We recognize that your current desire is to find a publisher interested in producing a hardcover book on the topic (working title: *R. M. Schindler and the California Desert*). Since the subject of this book falls squarely within PSPF's mission area, we also would be interested in exploring the possibility of PSPF publishing the book, or making the content of your research available through the PSPF website. You might recall that at the end of your briefing, various board members commented on the many significant advantages of publishing through PSPF.

We ask that the research work you described in your briefing to the PSPF board be completed before December 31, 2024. Additional conditions of this grant include:

1. Should you find a book publisher other than PSPF, that you ensure that PSPF's financial contribution to your research be prominently recognized in that book; or,
2. That should you not find a book publisher, that PSPF be granted full rights to publish any or all of the final research product in any format (electronic or hard copy) or any time we may deem appropriate; and,
3. That PSPF is authorized to make an announcement regarding this grant to publicize our grant program.

Accordingly, we are forwarding a grant check in the amount of \$6,000.00. We will consider your redemption of the check as acceptance of the conditions contained herein.
